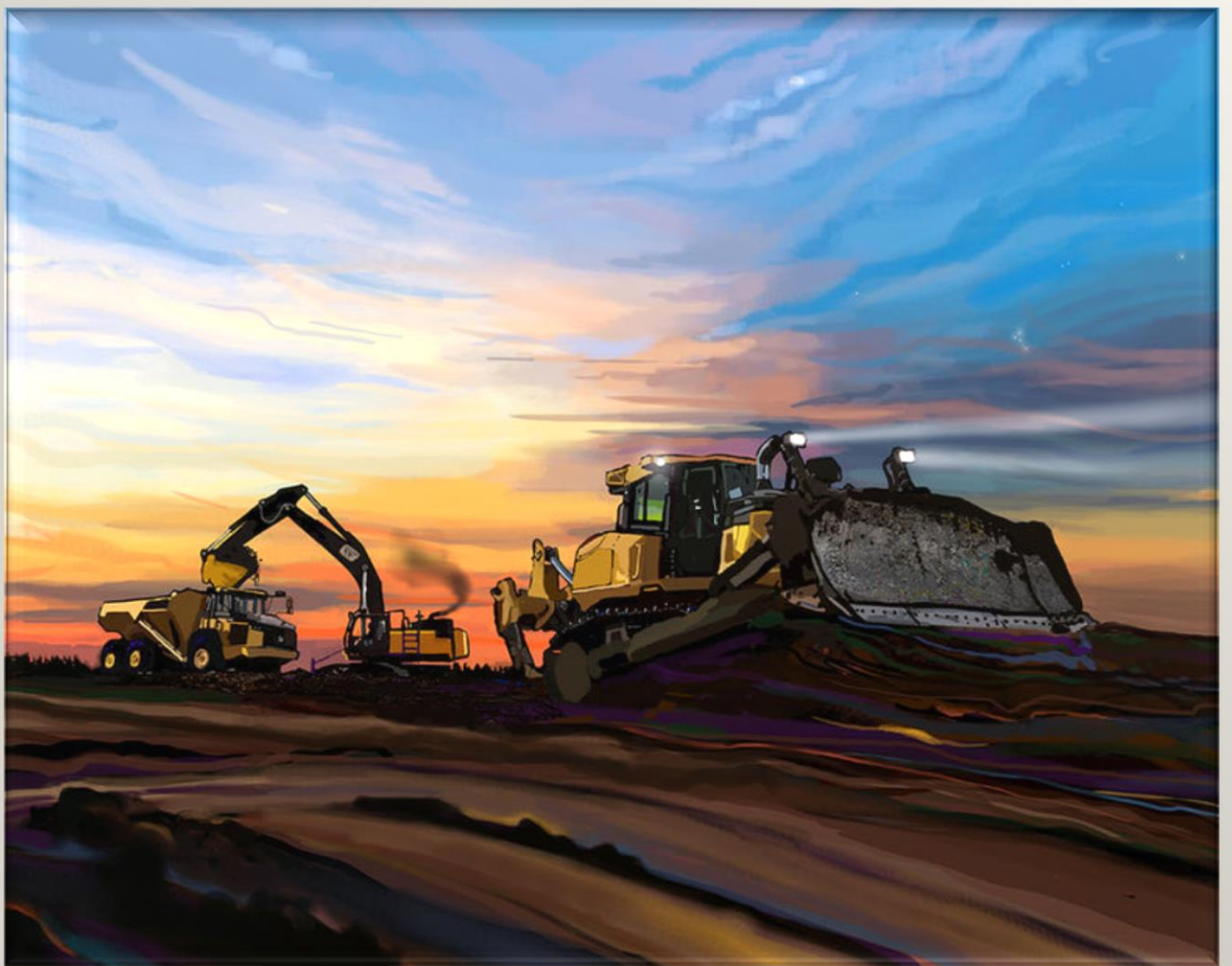

2018 Build Arizona Awards

General Requirements:

The competition is open to all Arizona Chapter AGC general contractor firms in good standing. All parties of a joint venture MUST be dues paying ARIZONA chapter AGC members.

Nominations for the 2018 Build Arizona awards must be submitted by the principals or officers of the applying firms, or with their permission.

Awards will be considered for new construction, reconstruction and pavement preservation work completed in 2017; awards will be presented for both public work and private work in these categories:
