#### **About the Awards**

## What are the awards?

The AZAGC Build Arizona Awards annally celebrate the construction achievements of AZAGC contractors. The program recognizes excellent projects, and outstanding companies, partnerships and individuals that go the extra mile to make a project a success.

Eligible projects are categorized by the dollar amount, location and procurement type (Design Bid Build, Job Order Contracting, Design Build, Construction Manager at Risk, and Public Private Partnerships.) Projects are then divided into four building disciplines – Heavy/Industrial, Highway Construction, Municipal, Utility, and Pavement Preservation.

The following critical elements are reviewed and considered when selecting the winning projects:

- · Levels of compliance
- · Outstanding craftsmanship
- · Technical innovation
- Sustainability
- Ability to solve technical issues with creative solutions
- Use of innovative products and skills to overcome difficult site conditions
- Safety projects with a fatality will be disqualified

# Why you should submit

- Gain recognition and increase your reputation within the industry
- · Reward your team for excellent work
- Meet clients and peers at the awards ceremony to raise your profile and develop future business

The uniqueness of the project will determine the Build Arizona Award winners.

#### **Entry Requirements**

The competition is open to all Arizona Chapter AGC general contractor firms in good standing with the chapter. All parties of a joint venture MUST be dues paying Arizona Chapter AGC members. Any company can choose to apply for any or all the award categories. A separate application and separate entry fee must be completed for each award category. Each application will be judged on its own merits and will not be influenced by the number of awards for which a company applies.

Awards may not be presented in every category. Please consider carefully which category to enter and ensure you address all the award criteria listed in the application. **Projects must have been completed in 2023.** Projects must be located within the boundaries of the state of Arizona. All parties of a Joint Venture MUST be AZAGC member firms in good standing. Principal or officer must sign the Contractor-Project Information Sheet (page 7.)

Applications for the 2023 Build Arizona Awards can be submitted in the following categories for both public and privately funded projects. Additional qualifying information includes location, type of work, and project delivery.

Highway Construction, Heavy/Industrial Construction, Municipal Utilities Construction

#### Reconstruction

Highway Construction, Heavy/Industrial Construction, Municipal and Utilities Construction

Pavement Preservation

#### **Deadline and Fee**

All entries must be submitted electronically in PDF format to administration@azagc.org by Friday, December 1, 2023 by 5:00 pm. Entries in any other format will not be accepted.

Each project nomination is subject to an entry fee of \$400.00. Entry fees must be paid when the application is submitted. Company checks or credit card transactions are accepted as payment. A 2% merchant processing fee will be added to the credit card transaction. Checks should be made payable to AZAGC and mailed to 1825 W. Adams, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

Photographs should be incorporated into the document; we suggest including pre-construction, construction and post-construction pictures.

### Narrative description (500 words maximum)

The narrative description must address all of the criteria listed below. Please make sure each one of the bullet points is a heading within your narrative and are arranged in this order.

- 1. Why the project should receive an award; uniqueness of project
- 2. Meeting the timeframe of the project (completed on schedule)
- 3. Scope of the project
- 4. Difficulties of project
- Contractors use of innovation and problem-solving techniques applied throughout the project
- 6. Unique safety challenges on the jobsite and the methods used to remedy the issues
- 7. Project design
- 8. Outstanding features of the project
- 9. Contractors contribution to the community
- 10. Media coverage and promotion of construction and AZAGC logos on project
- 11. Sensitivity to environment and surroundings
- Partnering
- 13. Excellence in client service were client's expectations met?

Entries should be submitted electronically in PDF format to administration@azagc.org by Friday, December 1, 2023 by 5:00 p.m.

Include front and back covers, contractor-project information sheet, narrative description, and up to ten photographs.

16 pages total (front and back) including cover page.

Entries and payments must be received by Friday, December 1, 2023 by 5:00 pm. Entries must be submitted electronically in PDF format to administration@azagc.org.

Winners will be notified the week of December 18-22, 2023.

Award recipients will be recognized at the AZAGC Annual Dinner & Awards Banquet on January 26, 2024.
