The commercial class includes potential storm water pollution sources and effects associated with commercial construction, land development, landscaping and home building activity. The class will also provide appropriate methods of erosion and sedimentation control and the industry standard control measures used to address erosion, sediment, and construction pollutants discharged from commercial construction activities.

Storm water Inspection techniques and in-class inspection exercise using photographs will be included with a focus on proper installation and maintenance versus rework and escalation.

The training curriculum includes Clean Water Act (CWA) regulatory understanding, permitting, inspection, proper construction site controls and practices; proper creation and upkeep of permit required documents such as the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), as well as the aspects and conditions of CWA Section 404 (Corps of Engineer permits) and Fugitive Dust Permits.
