Urine

Process

- Donor provides urine sample in the privacy of a restroom
- Specimen is tested onsite (rapid) or shipped to a lab
- Results are reported or Non-Negative lab results are reviewed by an MRO and result is reported to the employer once a donor interview is complete

Why Urine Testing

- Customization - Many panel options and configurations available
- Inexpensive
- Most common form of drug testing (95% of employers)
- Instant testing available

Drug	Detection Time
Amphetamine	2-3 days
Cocaine metabolites	2-4 days
Marijuana	
Infrequent use	1-3 days
Habitual use	Up to 30 days
Opioids	2-3 days
PCP	1-5 Days

➤ Drug Testing Options

Saliva

Process

- Collector places collection device in the donor's mouth
- Specimen is shipped to a lab
- Results are reported or Non-Negative lab results are reviewed by an MRO and result is reported to the employer once a donor interview is complete

Why Saliva Testing

- Less invasive
- Observed collections
- Fast procedure

Common Drugs / Detection Time

Drug	Detection Time
Amphetamine	1-2 days
Cocaine metabolites	1-2 days
Marijuana	
Infrequent use	1 day
Habitual use	1 day
Opioids	1-2 days
PCP	1-2 Days

➤ Drug Testing Options

Hair

Process

- Collector cuts 100-120 strands of hair (roughly the width of a pencil)
- Specimen is shipped to a lab
- Results are reported or Non-Negative lab results are reviewed by an MRO and result is reported to the employer once a donor interview is complete

Why Hair Testing

- Largest detection window
- Typically higher return of positive tests
- Observed collections

Common Drugs / Detection Time

Drug	Detection Time
Amphetamine	1-3 months
Cocaine metabolites	1-3 months
Marijuana	1-3 months
Opioids	1-3 months
PCP	1-3 months

Reasons for Testing

Reason for Test	Urine	Saliva	Hair
Pre-employment	Yes	Yes	Yes
Random	Yes	Yes	Yes
Reasonable Suspicion	Yes	Yes	No
Post-accident	Yes	Yes	No
Return to Duty	Yes	Yes	Yes
